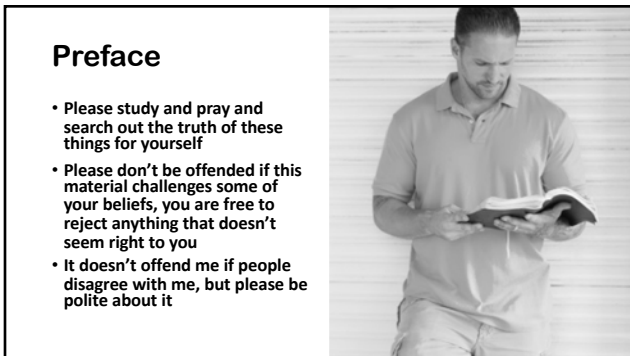

### Babylon as an Economic Empire

- Revelation 18 (about the fall of Babylon the Great)
  - 11 *And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more:*
  - 12 *The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble,*
  - 13 *And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men.*

### Characteristics of Spiritual Babylon

- "...sitteth upon many waters" (17:1)
- Has made the inhabitants of the earth "drunk" with the "wine of her fornication" (17:2)
- Has committed "fornication" with all the kings (rulers) of the earth (17:2)
- Her merchants were the great men of the earth (18:23) and were made rich through "the abundance of her delicacies" (18:3)
- Made merchandise of just about everything, including "slaves and souls of men" (18:12-13)
- Deceived all nations by her sorceries (18:23)
- Has shed the blood of the prophets, saints, and "all that were slain upon the earth" (18:24)

### The Mark of the Beast

- Revelation 13
  - 16 *And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:*
  - 17 *And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.*
- Note: Romans branded slaves on the back of the hand or forehead with the owner's name

- Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

### Usury is Forbidden

- Deuteronomy 23:19-20
  - Thou shalt not lend upon usury to thy brother; usury of money, usury of victuals, usury of any thing that is lent upon usury:
  - Unto a stranger (i.e. foreigner) thou mayest lend upon usury; but unto thy brother thou shalt not blend upon usury: that the Lord thy God may bless thee in all that thou settest thine hand to in the land whither thou goest to possess it.
- Leviticus 25:35-37
  - And if thy brother be waxen poor, and fallen in decay with thee; then thou shalt relieve him: yea, though he be a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with thee.
  - Take thou no usury of him, or increase: but fear thy God; that thy brother may live with thee.
  - Thou shalt not give him thy money upon usury, nor lend him thy victuals for increase.

### Land Sabbaths and Jubilee

- Consecrate the fiftieth year and proclaim liberty throughout the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you; each of you is to return to your family property and to your own clan. The fiftieth year shall be a jubilee for you; do not sow and do not reap what grows of itself or harvest the untended vines. For it is a jubilee and is to be holy for you; eat only what is taken directly from the fields. In this Year of Jubilee everyone is to return to their own property. (Leviticus 25:10-13)
